Undiagnosed Type 1 diabetes in children is a medical emergency.

Be vigilant to see if your child has ANY of the main symptoms of Type 1 diabetes. The main symptoms are known as the 4 Ts – Thirst, Toilet, Tiredness, Thinner. If you notice your child is thirsty or using the toilet more frequently, is always feeling tired, or has lost weight recently, please make an **urgent** GP appointment or contact the Out of Hours service.

Type 1 diabetes requires prompt treatment. NHS services are very well equipped to look after children safely if they are unwell. Please do not delay seeking medical advice because of COVID-19.
