Our work this term will include... 'Out of Africa'

- Identify the countries of Africa on a map. Where is Sudan located? What is the population of each country? Present this information in different formats (Bar charts, Pie charts, %, Fractions, decimals)
- What animals are under threat of extinction in Africa? Calculate a fraction or percentage of a quantity or measurement
- TASC – plan and design Madagascar costumes and props
- Look at the human/physical features of Africa
- Multi media presentations
- Identify the religions found in Africa
- Faith groups – beliefs on the natural world - Tribal Groups
- United nations/charitable organisations
- Coding using micro:bit
- Coding – Lego – Program an African animal
- Story writing – Adventure story - Plan and write a story based on 'A Long Walk to Water'
- Charities supporting famine (live aid etc.) – link to wars in Sudan and 'Long walk to water' book
- Weather conditions in Africa
- Composing African music
- Circle of Life – Create an Africa Savannah food chain. Diets – (vegetarian, vegan) Food Chains. Compare our diets with people from Africa
- Create an oracy presentation on an endangered animal
- Sex Education

Exploring this topic with your child at home will support their learning in school.



How you can help your child at home...

Google classroom – this is constantly used to share information with pupils. Y6 will be set home learning tasks via this platform.

Pupils can access their Hwb accounts from home. Each child has their own log in details.

Read with your child. Reading out loud helps with confidence and expression as well as fluency. Encourage your child to quiz on Accelerated Reader; they can access their accounts at home.

Doodle Maths this can be accessed at home. Practising times tables, these need to be learnt at speed. (72 in 100 seconds)

Ensure your child has their green bag in school daily this helps with communication.

Check your child's Home Learning Diary - tasks are being set regularly.

- If your child is to walk home on their own at the end of a school day please provide us with a letter

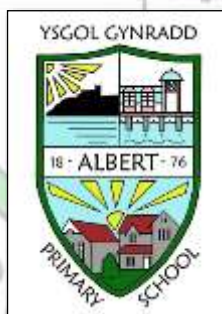


Key dates / events in our year group...
