Our work this term will include...

For the first half term we will be focusing on settling the children into the Nursery, making new friends and learning our Nursery routines. We will be looking at 'Jack and the Beanstalk', Jolly Phonics and Numberland. Children will experience 'learning time' everyday with the teacher. They will have the opportunity to explore the different areas of the Nursery such as the outdoor classroom, the construction area and the sensory and creative areas to name but a few. Throughout the week, children will also take part in focussed activities with the class teacher.

Our topic after half term will be 'Once Upon a Time' which will focus on traditional tales. We will be doing many exciting activities linked to different stories including Little Red Riding Hood, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Gingerbread Man.


