Our work this term will include...

During our 'World of Sport' topic we will be identifying human and natural features around Penarth and Tokyo, creating fact sheets comparing Wales and Japan, designing and creating a new logo for the Olympics and investigating the factors involved in long jump events.

In Language & Literacy we will be writing instructions for a new sport, researching different sports, re-writing the story of The Tortoise and the Hare, writing a sports-themed poem and creating a leaflet about the Olympics.

In Maths we will be comparing daily temperatures of venues of some of the countries competing in Euro 2021, learning how to tell the time using analogue and digital clocks and looking at right angles in relation to position (1/4 turns and 1/2 turns), looking at number patterns and measuring length, capacity and mass.

In ICT we will be collecting and interpreting data through tallying and bar charts.

After half term we will be learning how to code.
