Our work this term will include...

Our topic for the first four week is 'How Does Your Garden Grow?'. We will be looking at how plants grow and preparing the Nursery garden for planting. We will be reading the books 'Jasper's Beanstalk', 'From Seed to Sunflower' and 'Rosie Plants a Radish'. We will continue with Jolly Phonics and learning a new sound every week, as well as reviewing the ones we have learned already. Children will experience 'learning time' everyday with the teacher. They will have the opportunity to explore the different areas of the Nursery such as the outdoor classroom, the construction area and the sensory and creative areas to name but a few. Throughout the week, children will also take part in focussed activities with the class teacher.

Our next topic will be 'Superheroes'. We will be looking at books such as 'Supertato' and 'Megaboy', as well as learning about every day heroes such as the police, medical workers and firefighters. On Wednesday 12th May we would like the children to come to Nursery dressed as a superhero as part of our Immersion Day. Please ensure they don't bring any accessories/props, inline with Covid guidelines.

How you can help your child at home

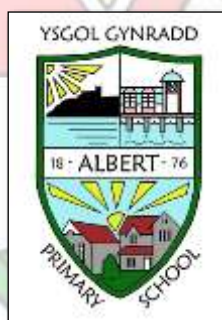


- Please teach your child how to put on their coat and do it up.
