Our work this term will include...

Literacy – Victorian grammar and vocabulary; Alice in Wonderland poetry; Osborne House pamphlet; Florence Nightingale; instructions and Victorian recipes; Oliver Twist story writing; Victorian inventions explanations; diary of a Victorian school child; formal letter to Lord Shafestbury; Victorian Penarth; playscripts and seaside postcards.

Maths – multiplication and division; fractions; addition and subtraction; data handling; weight; number word problems; time, timetables and calendars; measuring length in mm and cm; 3D shapes; symmetry and Victorian money.

ICT – ‘Data Handling’ e.g. spreadsheets and databases; stop motion animation of Oliver Twist; ‘Multimedia’ e.g. playscripts.

Ice Cool – ‘Victorian Detectives’ - Victorian timeline; photography and cameras; Queen Victoria; sketching portraits and self portraits; Victorian medicine; Albert Primary School; Victorian food; Victorian games; Victorian children; Victorian clothing; making peg dolls; Victorian schools; Victorian houses; Victorian leisure and seaside.

Science – ‘World of Water’ – organisms; water habitats; water minibeasts; water plants; life cycles; food chains; the effects of the seasons and pollution on the water environments.

R.E – ‘Special places’ – our special place; Earth day; different religious special places; St Augustines Church; Anglian churches; Christian baptism; Synagogues; Rabbi roles and responsibilities and the Shabbat.

Welsh – ‘Y Ty/The House’ – the types of buildings and towns we live in; different rooms within a house; different furniture within a house and home activities.

P.E – ‘Multiskills’ – including ball skills; agility; defending; attacking; developing reaction times and circuit activities.



### How you can help your child at home...

Logging in and out of Hwb and Google Classroom (Google for Education on Hwb). Please help your child to become independent in doing this.

Practising the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10 times tables (with a focus on this term's 8 times table).

Practical reinforcement of maths – e.g. time, fractions, weight, capacity, money and measurement.



Daily DoodleMaths and tables practice.

Reading regularly (books and myon.co.uk), checking their understanding of the story as their AR quizzes are based on comprehension.

Practicing spelling.

Practicing handwriting - the aim is that all children are using a pen by the end of Y3, however this is dependent on clear presentation and letter formation.

All children are encouraged to research our theme of 'The Victorians'.

### Things we need this term...

Please ensure that your child wears their P.E kit on their allocated day, including suitable footwear (Y3M Friday and Y3I Tuesday). Due to the fact that lessons are outside, the children will need navy or black jogging bottoms as part of their kit.

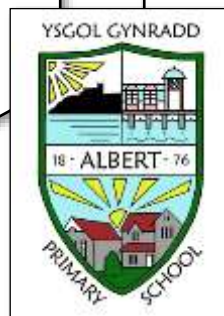
