The All Wales School Liaison Core Programme

Following PC Emma Mudie's retirement from her post, our new School Liaison Police Officer will be PC Chris Thompson. PC Thompson will be coming into school to deliver a number of lessons to our classes. The All Wales School Liaison Core Programme is a crime prevention programme funded jointly by the Welsh Government and the 4 Welsh Police Forces. The main aims of the programme are:

- To work towards achieving crime and disorder reduction within our young communities, through the medium of education.
- To promote the principles of positive citizenship, in school and the wider community.

The programme consists of lessons which are considered educational 'best practice' lessons and are taught by 85 educationally trained police officers working in partnership with teachers in support of the PSE curriculum in schools in Wales. The programme ensures that all children across Wales receive the same accurate up to date information about the dangers in regards to the 3 main themes of the programme which are:

- drugs and substance misuse
- social behaviour and community
- personal safety

It is a spiral scheme of work spanning Foundation Phase to Key Stage Four utilising police expertise to complement and support the good work in schools. The officers deliver the lessons throughout primary, secondary schools and PRU units across Wales to children and young people between the ages of five and sixteen years.
