Health and Well Being

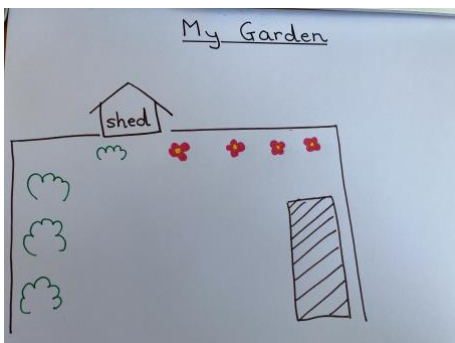

Parents/Carers: try numbers 1 – 3 at first if necessary and then add one new number at a time.
