Going Global

- Dragon's Den – Create your own company. Design and make a product to present to the Dragon's. Consider sustainability of materials, market research, work to a budget, project sales and profits, create an advert, design a logo, write formal letters to prospective suppliers and retailers. Present a pitch to the Dragon's using a variety of media. Sell products at a Trade Fayre.
- Budgets – how do we manage our money
- Fairtrade – looking at ethics of global products
- Map work – locate and plot global brands from around the world
- UK import and export partnerships
- What is a global citizen
- Global environmental issues
- Recording our feelings about global issues in the form of a VLOG
- Tourist Brochures – working for Tourism Wales advertise tourist places in Wales – Curriculum Cymraeg
- Polar Explorer Programme – developing an understanding of the challenges faced by polar explorers

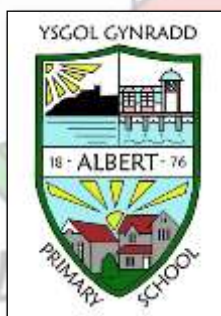
