Year 2 to 6 Personalised Tests

The Welsh Government have advised schools to continue to use personalised assessment resources, on a reasonable endeavours basis, to enable teachers to understand and support individual learner needs. The most valuable way to use the assessments will be in a formative way to identify any gaps and plan for future learning. There will be no formal national test week this year, but the children will complete their online assessments as part of their normal classroom learning activities between Monday 10th May to Friday 21st May. Their results will be communicated to you in the end of year reports in July.
