Language, Literacy and Communication

Can you think of people who help us? Ask a grown up to help write a list (e.g. firefighter, police officer, doctor, nurse, dentist, teacher, parents). Can you recognise any letters/sounds in the list? Can you try to write some of these letters yourself? There are lots of different ways you could practise your writing, with pencils, crayons, paint, writing in sand/glitter/rice. If you have a large piece of paper, get someone to draw around you. Can you number your fingers and toes? If not, draw a picture of yourself on a small piece of paper.


Health and Well-being
